

## Directions to Flaunden Village Hall

Flaunden is a rural village and is approached via lanes rather than major roads. Sat navs and Google maps will tend to direct you along the shortest route which is often via the narrowest and most winding of these lanes.

The area around Flaunden is popular with cyclists, horse riders and walkers so please be aware of these other road users.

The following pages give directions to the hall from:

- Chipperfield
- Bovingdon
- Little Chalfont
- Sarratt via Chipperfield
- Chorleywood via Latimer
- M25 Junction 18 via Latimer
- M25 Junction 20 via Kings Langley (suggested route for lorries, avoiding single track lanes)
- M1 Junction 7/8 via Hemel Hempstead and Bovingdon

We recommend that you follow these directions rather than sat nav. The hall does not have a postcode but HP3 0PP is adjacent to the hall.

## From Chipperfield or Bovingdon down Flaunden Lane

1	From <b>Bovingdon</b> go along <b>Chipperfield Road</b> towards Chipperfield.	From <b>Chipperfield</b> go along <b>Tower Hill</b> towards Bovingdon.
2	At the crossroads <b>turn right</b> down <b>Flaunden Lane</b> (signposted Flaunden).	At the crossroads past Wyvale Garden Centre <b>turn left</b> down <b>Flaunden Lane</b> (signposted Flaunden).
3	Follow for one mile. Carry <b>straight on</b> at the crossroads at The Bricklayers Arms and up the hill to <b>Flaunden Village</b> .	
4	Carry <b>straight on</b> at the crossroads in centre of village.	
5	<b>Flaunden Village Hall</b> is 100 yards on the <b>left</b> .	

## From Little Chalfont

1	<b>Turn left</b> off <b>A404 Amersham Road</b> onto <b>Stony Lane</b> , just after the national speed limit sign.
2	At the crossroads at the bottom of the lane, go <b>straight ahead</b> towards <b>Latimer</b> .
3	Go over the bridge and follow road through Latimer, the roads bears slightly right and then goes along the valley for about a mile (the road is now called Flaunden Hill).
4	Carry on <b>up the hill</b> to <b>Flaunden Village</b> .
5	At the top the road bears to the right, then to the left. Take these corners slowly as it's very difficult to see cars coming, or for them to see you. Go past the Green Dragon pub.
6	<b>At the crossroads</b> in the centre of the village <b>turn right</b> .
7	<b>Flaunden Village Hall</b> is 100 yards on the <b>left</b> .

If you reach the Bricklayer's Arms, then you've turned the wrong way at the crossroads! Turn around and drive straight ahead to reach the hall.

## From Sarratt via Chipperfield

1	Head <b>north-west</b> out of Sarratt on <b>The Green</b> towards Chipperfield.
2	At Belsize <b>do not turn onto Bragmans Lane or Flaunden Lane</b> as the lane is single track with few passing places (they do go to Flaunden and sat navs may try and send you this way).
3	Road becomes <b>Poles Hill</b> then <b>Dunny Lane</b> .
4	At the crossroads in Chipperfield by the KIA garage <b>turn left</b> onto <b>Tower Hill</b> towards Bovingdon.
5	At the crossroads past Wyvale Garden Centre <b>turn left</b> down <b>Flaunden Lane</b> (signposted Flaunden).
6	Follow for one mile. Carry <b>straight on</b> at the crossroads at The Bricklayers Arms and up the hill to <b>Flaunden Village</b> .
7	Carry <b>straight on</b> at the crossroads in centre of village.
8	<b>Flaunden Village Hall</b> is 100 yards on the <b>left</b> .

## From Chorleywood

1	<b>Turn left</b> onto the <b>A404 Amersham Road</b> either at the top of Green Street or Common Road.
2	<b>Turn right</b> towards <b>Chenies</b> (the road is called Latimer Road but there is no sign giving the name).
3	Follow road through Chenies past the Bedford Arms.
4	<b>Ignore your sat nav when it tells you to turn right as you're starting to leave the village.</b> The turning is quite hidden and the single track lane beyond (Chenies Hill) is very winding and rough in places, although it will take you to Flaunden. *
5	At the cross roads <b>turn right</b> onto Stony Lane towards <b>Latimer</b> .
6	Go over the bridge and follow road through Latimer, the roads bears slightly right and then goes along the valley for about a mile (the road is now called Flaunden Hill).
7	Carry on <b>up the hill</b> to <b>Flaunden Village</b> .
8	At the top the road bears to the right, then to the left. Take these corners slowly as it's very difficult to see cars coming, or for them to see you. Go past the Green Dragon pub.
9	<b>At the crossroads</b> in the centre of the village <b>turn right</b> .
10	<b>Flaunden Village Hall</b> is 100 yards on the <b>left</b> .

If you reach the Bricklayer's Arms, then you've turned the wrong way at the crossroads!  
Turn around and drive straight ahead to reach the hall.

\*If you do turn onto Chenies Hill then you have two options:

1. Go over the hump back bridge then turn around at Roberts Farm and turn right back onto Latimer Road.

As you approach Flaunden you will pass the RAF Radar station (big golf ball on a stick) on your left. Keep following the lane as it bends to the right and left. Go past the fields and the hall is on your right.

## From M25 Junction 18 via Latimer

1	<b>From the south (M40, M4, M3) take M25 clockwise</b> towards Watford.	<b>From the north (M1, M11) take M25 anticlockwise</b> towards Heathrow.
2	<b>Exit M25 at Junction 18</b> (signposted Chorleywood).	<b>Exit M25 at Junction 18</b> (signposted Chorleywood).
3	At top of slip road <b>turn left</b> at the lights onto <b>A404</b> towards <b>Amersham</b>	At top of slip road <b>turn right</b> at the lights onto <b>A404</b> towards <b>Amersham</b> .
4	Pass a Shell Garage 50 yds on your right and <b>straight on</b> at the next two sets of lights.	
5	Continue on the A404 for approx 2 miles. You will pass St Clement Danes school on your left then in another 600 yards <b>turn right</b> towards <b>Chenies</b> (the road is called Latimer Road but there is no sign giving the name).	
6	Follow road through Chenies past the Bedford Arms.	
7	<b>Ignore your sat nav when it tells you to turn right as you're starting to leave the village.</b> The turning is quite hidden and the single track lane beyond (Chenies Hill) is very winding and rough in places, although it will take you to Flaunden. *	
8	At the cross roads <b>turn right</b> onto Stony Lane towards <b>Latimer</b> .	
9	Go over the bridge and follow road through Latimer, the roads bears slightly right and then goes along the valley for about a mile (the road is now called Flaunden Hill).	
10	Carry on <b>up the hill</b> to <b>Flaunden Village</b> .

## From M25 Junction 20 via Kings Langley (suggested route for lorries, avoiding single track lanes)

1	<b>From the south (M40, M4, M3) take M25 clockwise</b> towards Watford.	<b>From the north (M1, M11) take M25 anticlockwise</b> towards Heathrow.
2	<b>Exit M25 at Junction 20</b> (signposted Kings Langley).	<b>Exit M25 at Junction 20</b> (signposted Kings Langley).
3	At bottom of slip road take <b>second exit</b> to <b>A4251 to Kings Langley</b> .	At bottom of slip road take <b>third exit</b> to <b>A4251 to Kings Langley</b> .
4	Over mini roundabout into village- <b>turn left after pedestrian lights</b> into <b>Langley Hill</b> .	
5	Sharp bend to right at top of hill then at crossroads <b>turn left</b> into <b>Chipperfield Road</b> .	
6	In approx. 1¼ miles <b>turn right at Spice House/Kia Garage</b> into <b>Tower Hill</b> .	
7	In just over one mile <b>turn left</b> into <b>Flaunden Lane</b> (narrow lanes).	
8	Follow for one mile. Carry <b>straight on</b> at the crossroads at The Bricklayers Arms and up the hill to <b>Flaunden Village</b> .	
9	Carry <b>straight on</b> at the crossroads in centre of village.	
10	<b>Flaunden Village Hall</b> is 100 yards on the <b>left</b> .	

## Travelling from M1 Junction 7/8 via Hemel Hempstead and Bovingdon

Sat navs and Google maps will try to send you via Felden which is a single track lane with few passing places. Coming via Bovingdon is an easier drive.

1	Exit <b>M1</b> at <b>Junction 7/8</b> onto the A414 (signposted Hemel Hempstead).
2	Follow signs to <b>Hemel Hempstead</b> going straight on at several roundabouts and traffic lights.
3	You will reach the <b>Plough Roundabout</b> which is actually several mini roundabouts. Go in a clockwise direction and <b>exit at the fourth mini roundabout</b> onto <b>Station Road</b> (signposted to Bovingdon/Hemel Hempstead station). Do not exit at the third mini roundabout as this will take you via Felden which is a single track lane with few passing places.*
4	Turn <b>right at the next roundabout</b> onto <b>A4251</b> .
5	Go <b>straight ahead at the next roundabout</b> (by Hemel Hempstead station) and under the railway bridge.
6	There are two sets of traffic lights in quick succession. At the <b>second set of lights turn left</b> towards <b>Bovingdon</b> (Box Lane). Sat navs may direct you to turn left at the first set of lights but this is also via Felden.
7	Go <b>up the hill</b> for about 2 miles until you reach <b>Bovingdon</b> .
8	<b>Turn left</b> at the double roundabout onto Bovingdon <b>High Street</b> (signposted <b>Chipperfield</b> ).
9	Go through the village and carry <b>straight on</b> for about a mile towards Chipperfield (High Street becomes Chipperfield Road).
10	At the crossroads <b>turn right</b> down <b>Flaunden Lane</b> (signposted Flaunden).
11	Follow for one mile. Carry <b>straight on</b> at the crossroads at The Bricklayers Arms and up the hill to <b>Flaunden Village</b> .
12	Carry <b>straight on</b> at the crossroads in centre of village.
13	<b>Flaunden Village Hall</b> is 100 yards on the <b>left</b> .

## **Travelling from M1 Junction 7/8 cont.**

\*If you do leave at the third mini roundabout (onto Two Waters Road) then turn right at the crossroads traffic lights onto the A4251, then straight ahead at the next roundabout. Continue following the directions from step 5 above.

\*\* If you do take the road to Felden then there are two options:

1. Turn around and go via Bovingdon (recommended)
2. Go up the hill. At the Y junction turn right onto Felden Lane (single track with few passing places). Carry on for about 1.4 miles. At the crossroads go straight ahead onto Flaunden Lane. Continue following the directions from step 11 above.
